

MASTER OF MUSIC IN MUSIC EDUCATION  
Sample Degree Plan: Three Summers Plus Project

The Master of Music in Music Education degree program comprises fifteen (15) courses—five each from among the three areas of Music Core, Major Courses, and Electives. Please note the following four points.

1. Some required courses are offered every summer; others are scheduled in alternating summers. Music education courses (required and elective) are scheduled on a three-year rotation. It is important to consult with your adviser for course planning.
2. Unless otherwise indicated by footnote, each academic course is one week in length—Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
3. The Sample Plan below does not include the “Performance” Music Core. Consult with your adviser about how best to meet this requirement.
4. Up to three (3) courses can be transferred into your program. Consult with your adviser for details.
