



Online Graduate Statistics Courses for PhD Program

The Duquesne University School of Nursing has collaborated with the School of Education and the School of Leadership and Professional Advancement (SLPA) to provide two online statistics courses that the School of Nursing requires as prerequisites for the PhD program:

- GREV 510 Statistics I (fall)
- GREV 610 Statistics II (spring)

The courses are limited to 10 students. Priority will be given to students currently enrolled in the PhD Nursing program and to students who are interested in applying to the PhD Nursing Program for the following year.

1. For current PhD Nursing students:
