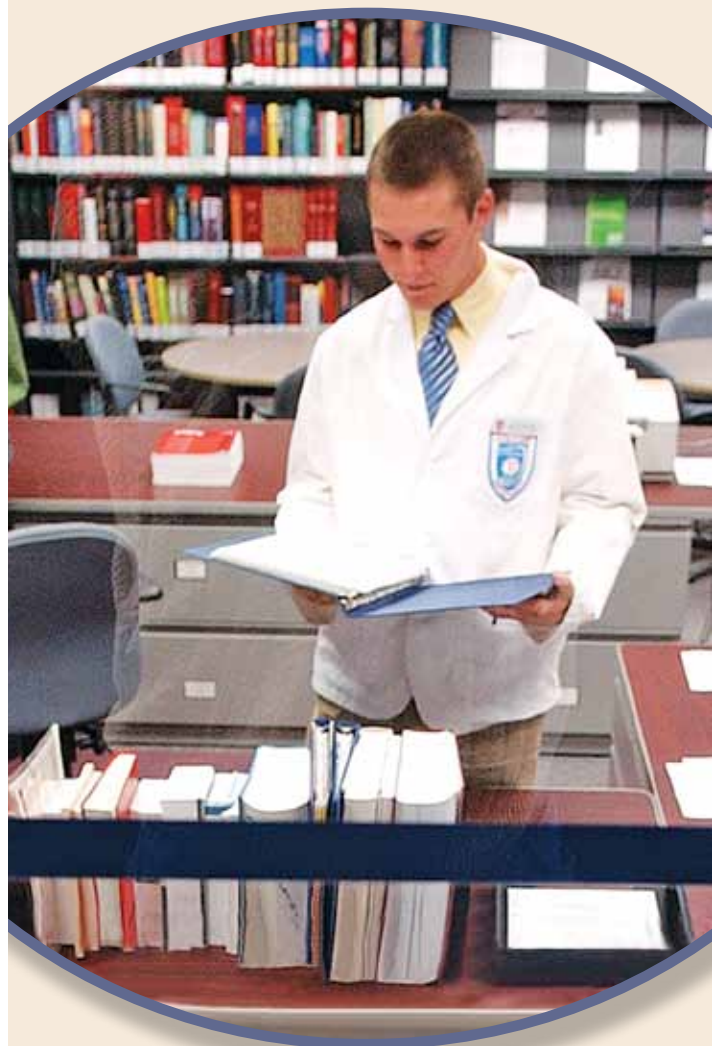

ABOUT THE CENTER

The Pharmaceutical Information Center is a drug information service established in 1998 and located in the Mylan School of Pharmacy at Duquesne University.

The Center concentrates its efforts on supplying information related to new drugs, adverse reactions, drug interactions, foreign products, drug use during pregnancy and lactation, identification of solid dosage forms, dosage, dietary supplements, complementary and alternative medicines and intravenous compatibilities.

The Pharmaceutical Information Center DOES NOT provide counseling services for drug

and alcohol abuse, nor does it distribute literature on the topics. In addition, the Center DOES NOT offer information on poisoning.
