Executive and Leader Coaching

Offered through the Duquesne University School of Business Professional Coach Certification Program (PCCP) and taught by Gary Slyman, PCC.



This elective course is for students that have completed an ACTP Accredited program, with a minimum of 125 hours of coach training. We will consider the special contexts and challenges faced by coaches who are working with leaders and executives in organizations. While the foundational skills of coaching remain the same, this course is designed to address the unique needs and perspectives of executives and leaders. In addition, participants will learn about contracting with organizations, developing and building relationships with organizations and sponsors, and establishing a professional presence.

Major Topics

The primary focus of this course is to introduce you to the unique context of executive and leader coaching and to help you understand how you might apply your coaching skills successfully in this context. Importantly, you will learn how executive coaching is both different from AND the same as other coaching niches. You will also learn about the processes and practices of executive coaching and what additional competencies and areas of expertise you should develop to coach organizational leaders credibly and ethically.
