Professional Master of Business Administration

The Professional MBA consists of 36 credits of required Core courses and 6 credits of Fundamental courses. Fundamental courses may be waived if you have taken equivalent coursework within the past 5 years and have earned a B- or better. Wavier decisions are made and communicated at time of admission.

Fundamental courses are offered every semester in a fully online, asynchronous format.

Core courses are offered in person every semester and in an asynchronous online format one time per year. In-person courses meet from 6:00 – 8:40pm in fall and spring semesters and from 6:00 – 9:20pm in the summer semester.

Courses that are 3 credits will meet for a full semester, and courses that are 1.5 credits will meet for the first half or second half of the semester.
