Enrollment Status: The student is responsible for notifying the Financial Aid Office of any change in enrollment status (Full Time, Part Time, Less Than Half Time) AND number of registered credits. For most federal aid, students must be at least half-time status.

Please Note: Due to limited funding, normally only full-time students will be considered for programs of aid included on this application. Full Time enrollment status for Undergraduates = 12 credits/semester. Graduate Student enrollment status varies for each school. Please check with your Academic Advisor for determination of full or part time status.

Housing Status While in School: Awards are based on housing status indicated on the FAFSA (or this application if the FAFSA is not filed). The student is responsible for notifying the Financial Aid Office of any change in housing status.

Federal Direct Stafford Loans – Subsidized and/or Unsubsidized: Loan limits for undergraduate students are based on the student's current grade level – see: studentaid.gov. Graduate students are eligible for a maximum of \$20,500 in Federal Direct Stafford Loans per academic year (fall, spring and summer). First-time Stafford Loan borrowers are required to complete Entrance Loan Counseling and a Stafford Loan Master Promissory Note (MPN) before loan funds will be released. New borrowers can complete the Entrance Loan Counseling and the MPN at studentaid.gov.

Federal Direct Parent/Graduate PLUS Loan only: Dependent, Undergraduate students whose parents only apply for the Federal Direct Parent PLUS Loan are required to submit the FAFSA on line at studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa. Graduate students must utilize their maximum Stafford Loan eligibility before borrowing from the Direct Graduate PLUS Loan program. Additional information is available at studentaid.gov

Alternative Loans: Duquesne students are free to choose any financial institution to borrow an alternative educational loan.

Sources of aid and notification of eligibility: Students who complete both the Duquesne Financial Aid Application (if required) and the FAFSA before the MAY 1 deadline will be considered for all forms of Federal, State, and University need-based aid opportunities including scholarships, grants, loans, and work-study. A Financial Aid Award Letter or email notification will be sent to students notifying them of their eligibility. Current students can view their aid on DORI Self Service Banner.

Outside Awards: Receipt of outside awards could affect your eligibility for programs of aid awarded by the Financial Aid Office. Therefore, if you anticipate receipt of any outside funds, please indicate these sources in the space provided on the reverse. This will enable the Financial Aid Office to include these awards in your initial package and prevent later adjustments.

Pennsylvania State Grant –Students must file the FAFSA for Pennsylvania State Grant consideration. FAFSA Deadline for PA State Grant: **before May 1, 2021.**

Nursing, and Health Professions Loans: Eligible students will be offered Nursing, or Health Professions Loans. Need is a primary factor; repayment begins after discontinuance of at least Half Time enrollment; interest rates vary. Promissory notes must be signed by the second week of classes each semester or loan will be cancelled. First-time borrowers are required to complete Entrance Loan Counseling at www.duq.edu/financial-aid/loans before loan funds will be released.

Academic and Need-Based Awards: If you received any of the following awards in 2020-2021, they will be renewed provided you have not exceeded the maximum number of semesters (8 semesters for bachelor degree students, 10 semesters for Pharmacy students), as well as any other specific requirements, such as continued enrollment in a particular program. Students must be enrolled Full Time.

Federal Work-Study (FWS): Awards are based on need and available positions. Job placement is not guaranteed and funds awarded are paid directly to the student and are not deducted from actual billable costs (tuition, fees, and room and board (if applicable)). Students who will not utilize FWS funds are responsible for cancelling or declining the awards. Not declining awards may impact eligibility for other aid programs.
