What to do when Student Health Service is closed?

ON-CAMPUS RESIDENTS:

- **CALL PUBLIC SAFETY (Campus Police) 412-396-2677(COPS)**
- Residence Life Staff will assist with summoning D.U. Public Safety.
- The Residence Hall staff and Public Safety both have access to a Registered Nurse from Health Service if necessary.
- Campus Police will transport students to and from an Emergency Department depending upon severity of situation and will summon paramedics if needed.
- **UPMC Mercy Hospital/Trauma Center is located across Stevenson Street at the edge of campus.**

OFF CAMPUS RESIDENTS / COMMUTERS:

- DIAL 9-1-1 IF YOU ARE EXPERIENCING A LIFE-THREATENING EMERGENCY
- If non-life threatening, proceed to the nearest Urgent Care or Emergency Department.
