## INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS HEALTH CHECKLIST

International Students are required to submit the following health information:

**MMR** (Measles/Mumps/Rubella), or single component vaccinations of each.

- MMR Vaccine is given throughout the world to infants and young children to make them immune from those three childhood diseases. Becoming infected with them in adulthood is very dangerous.
- Please obtain these immunizations prior to your arrival. If you must obtain the vaccine in the United States, you can contact the Duquesne University Center For pharmacy Care to provide required vaccines.

**IGRA blood test**

- Must be done within two weeks of your planned arrival in the United States. If not done prior to arrival, The IRGA blood test is available at DUHS.
- Tuberculosis is an **extremely contagious** bacterial infection of the lungs caused by the bacteria Mycobacterium Tuberculosis.
- Vaccination with BCG does not preclude you from tuberculosis screening.

**Meningitis Vaccine** (required for on-campus housing)

- Meningococcal disease is a serious illness caused by a type of bacteria called Neisseria meningitidis.
- It can lead to meningitis (infection of the lining of the brain and spinal cord) and infections of the blood.
- Meningococcal disease often occurs without warning – even among people who are otherwise healthy.
- Meningococcal disease can spread from person to person through close contact and close living arrangements.

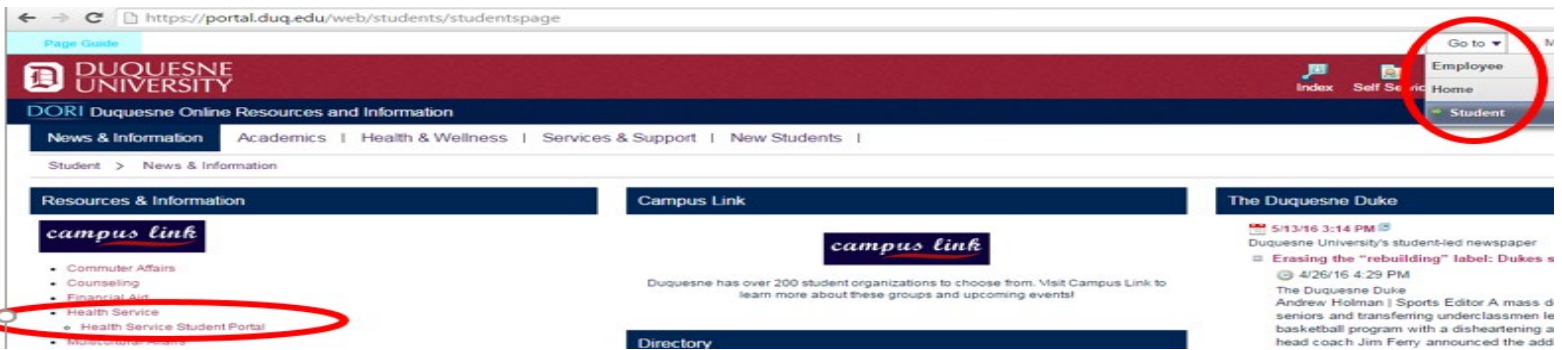
**Medical Health History**

- This is a list of questions about your health.
- Physical-examination by a physician is not required.
- A completed history form is required.

### 5. Covid vaccine

- Required for any student on campus for any reason

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1. Using your Multipass Username and Password, from the Duquesne University Website, please login to DORI. At the main page, please go to drop down on right side of page and pick STUDENT.

2. Go to left side of page under resources and information, please click HEALTH SERVICES STUDENT PORTAL. (under the Health Services tab) and enter **Immunization dates** (under the Immunization tab). **Documents** of vaccinations must be *accurate and true*, must be uploaded (Upload tab) or you can bring them with you to campus and then to our office.

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IF THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS ARE NOT COMPLETED PRIOR TO YOUR ARRIVAL, YOU MUST BE COMPLETED UPON YOUR ARRIVAL. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION WILL BE PROVIDED AT THE INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ORIENTATION UPON YOUR ARRIVAL TO CAMPUS.
