

SCHENGEN TERRITORY

Regulations on Length of Stay

U.S and Canadian citizens can travel VISA FREE in the Schengen Territories for a total of 90 days within in a 180 Day period.

****YOU CANNOT TRAVEL TO EUROPE FOR STUDY NOR VACATION 6 MONTHS PRIOR OR POST TO YOUR ITALIAN CAMPUS EXPERIENCE****

Do I need a Visa if I am a US/Canadian Passport Holder to study in Rome?*

NO

Schengen regulations stipulate that U.S Students participating in academic programs of 90 days or less do not require a study visa.

*If you are not a citizen of the US, Canada, or a European Union state, you will need a visa to study in Italy. Please contact the Center for Global Engagement for more information.

Since our program is exactly 90 days, this means that you cannot arrive in Italy or any other Schengen state ahead of your program start date or stay after your program. Other European Union member states, such as Britian and Ireland, are not Schengen States and have separate visa-free time limits for their own territories.

Once you have reached your 90-Day stay you must leave the Schengen Territory or you could face deportation.
