2. Read pp. 1-37 of the casebook: Christina L. Kunz and Carol L. Chomsky, *CONTRACTS: A CONTEMPORARY APPROACH* (3d ed.), West Interactive Casebook Series (2018), ISBN: 978-1-68328-815-2. You do not need an online access code for this course. You can rent or purchase a new or used version of the casebook.
