- Describe basic concepts related to pedagogy and presentation skills
- Create/execute effective teaching plans within didactic/clinical settings
- Compare/contrast teaching methods used in large classroom and small group settings
- Compose a teaching philosophy that displays individual goals related to teaching
- Identify strategies for continued self-improvement related to education and learning

## **The training program is conducted over the course of a full year (July-June) and includes:**

- 10+ hours of live and/or streaming seminar discussions
- Execution of 2 hours of lecture through continuing education (CE) and interactive teaching presentations
- Design and delivery of one journal club
- Observation of 2 hours of didactic lectures
- Participation in active learning sessions
- Precepting of Advance Pharmacy Practice Experience students
- Creation of a teaching portfolio and teaching philosophy
