SCIENCE/MATH G.P.A. CALCULATION:

TOTAL POINTS from Math AND Science sections divided by TOTAL CREDITS from Math AND Science sections equals MATH/SCIENCE G.P.A.

$$\frac{\text{Math AND Science Points}}{\text{Math AND Science Credits}} = \text{Science/Math GPA}$$
