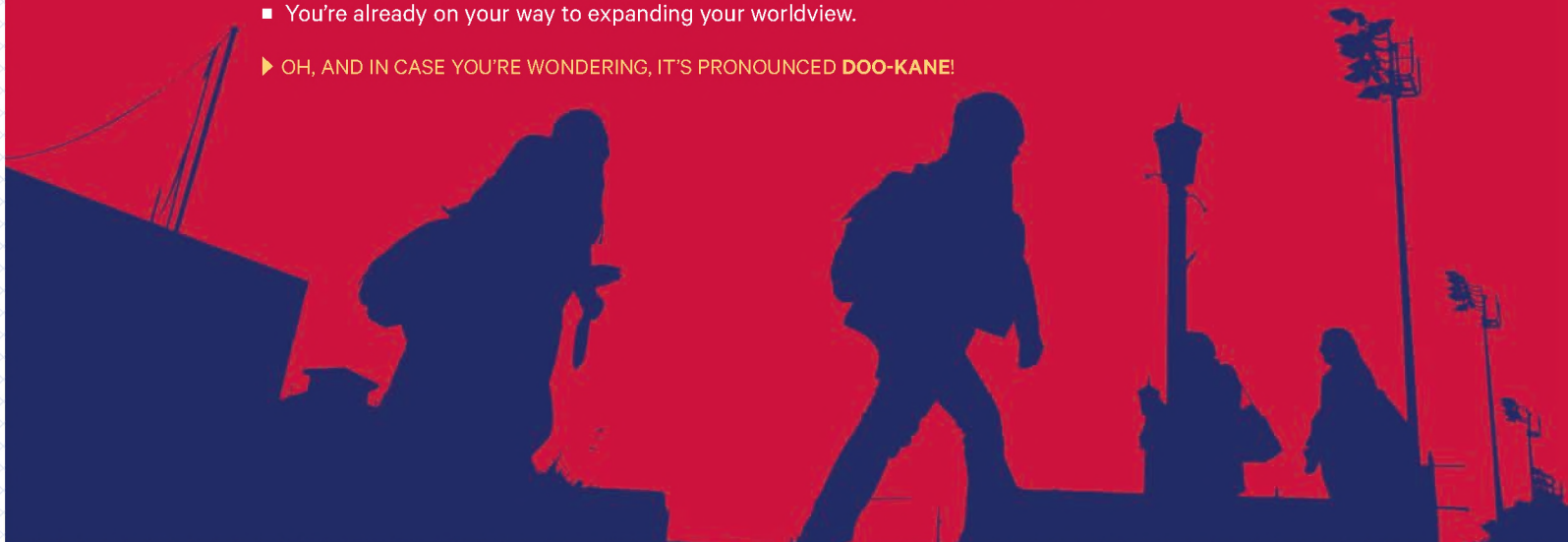

Undergraduate Students: International students who are accepted to Duquesne qualify for the Libermann Scholarship. Accepted students are automatically considered for the merit-based scholarship ranging from \$9,000 to \$28,000 per academic year.
